- Formed in Jan 2019
- 5 Board Members (2 in AL, 1 in NC, 1 in CO, 1 in TN)
- Mission: Cultivate and maintain a national registry of volunteer sUAS (small Unmanned Aircraft Systems) pilots with expertise and training in Search/Rescue (SAR) & Damage Assessment
- All registered pilots are FAA licensed (Part 107) commercial drone pilots, trained in Search/Rescue operations
- As of June 5 2019, the DSAR Registry has 46 pilots in 24 states
- Offer free training to Law Enforcement
- Conduct free quarterly training in use of sUAS in support of SAR operations, open to any pilot regardless of experience
- Started training in Damage Assessment flights as well
- Fosters synergy in the drone pilot community
- Free resource for all drone pilots
